Finally the President wished to congratulate SH Norris who has managed to entice over 140 OMs to attend the London Dinner at Haberdashers' Hall on November 20th 2015.

The President made special mention of the enormous contributions to the OMC by BJ Margrett (45-51) and IT Hodgson (44-51) who both sadly passed away earlier this year.

4. Treasurer's Report
